Hello

s9(2)(a) called about her on-going issues with being placed in an HNZ property. She said she has been on the list for over a year, she was offered a home in July but after waiting several months for the property to be vacated she was told the house had methamphetamine contamination and that it was going to cost too much to clean so she would go back in the process to be allocated another home. s9(2)(a) said she was then offered a property in December but that she declined this as she thought the house was not suitable for her children.

s9(2)(a) said that she is getting conflicting messages from HNZ about the previous house she was offered. The houses has been cleaned, contractors told her it was all clear but HNZ advised that the house was having further tests done. s9(2)(a) would ideally like to be housed in this property – she indicated that HNZ told this would be possible once it was fixed.

Could you please look into this and let me know what is happening with this application and could someone call s9(2)(a) to clarify the situation and her options (ie should she no longer be holding out hope of having this house and waiting for another offer and does she need to check in with MSD to ensure her application reflects her circumstances correctly – she mentioned living in a shed for the last few months).
