Housing New Zealand terminates tenancies by issuing a 90 day notice or through the Tenancy Tribunal.

The overall number of 90 day notices for anti-social behaviour and illegal activity is increasing as Housing New Zealand has a greater focus on the risks that anti-

These terminations include a rising number of cases where methamphetamine is involved.

The Corporation has a zero-tolerance stance toward anti-social behaviour including the manufacture and use of methamphetamine and other illegal behaviour. In
