











A. No, although in one case we assisted a tenant whose home contents were not insured with a payment to replace some items.

*Q. Who monitors or manages these rental properties?*

A. We work with a reputable rental agent, but we are responsible for their management, and take the welfare of our tenants seriously.

*Q. Are your tenants concerned?*

A. The affected tenants understand the need to move, and that we are supporting them in every way we can.

*Q. Do you think the contamination occurred when they were NZ Defence Force houses?*

A. We have no way of knowing when the contamination occurred or who was responsible. We are working closely with the police and other experts.

*Q. Do you think Hobsonville Point might be a magnet for P labs?*

A. No, not at all. This is an issue affecting only a small number of older homes slated for redevelopment in the near future. It's nothing to do with the new portion of the development at Hobsonville Point. We are testing as extensively as we now propose as a precautionary measure.
