

Online training for methamphetamine management

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Business alert for all staff.

Housing New Zealand is introducing a new training module to help you learn about the new policy, procedures and guidelines for identifying and responding to methamphetamine (P) in our properties. All staff are invited to complete the online training, which will take less than an hour to complete.

The training aims to support the procedures document in highlighting the key steps and action points throughout the process when methamphetamine contamination is suspected, including managing and arranging for sampling (testing) and decontamination. It highlights the main changes that have occurred with the release of the new procedures and will assist staff in understanding what their role entails.
