Hi there,

This afternoon Hon Bennett and Hon Smith have a meeting regarding Housing NZ and the methamphetamine issue.

Could we please urgently request

1. the most recent figures for this meeting? This is what we have that was supplied for the estimates - as at 30 April 2016:

- **580** properties are vacant due to methamphetamine contamination
- **7** properties have been demolished as they unable to be remediated
- over **\$10 million** spent on testing and remediation.

It would also be great if there is a regional breakdown (esp number of these houses in Auckland.

2. Some bullets on current processes around preventing/addressing methamphetamine contamination – hopefully this can be pulled from existing sources?

I'm afraid we need this by midday please. Apologies for the urgency!
