Lucy - apparently it is being announced at 10.30 Monday. Did you know that? MOH have very much kept us at arms length from this process, so some of our information is scant.

You may be able to get more certainty on launch details Minister to Minister.

Justine has been working on Comms - she is going to tidy some of the messages on Sunday and will have something more final for the team to review. We have also a meeting for 9am Monday to run through last steps in how we communicate to our staff, suppliers, contractors and tenants. Justine will loop you in on final messaging.

One thing that (may or may not be correct) is that I understand MOH is not releasing any health messaging. Speaking to Peter Abernathy tonight he didn't seem to be aware of any such messaging coming from the Ministry. So implicitly MOH are implying that by raising the guideline there is no impact on a persons health, but they are not going to say it explicitly. Peter is not leading the project - Paul Prendergast is - so it's possible that this may not be correct.

I find it a bit bizarre that MOH wouldn't have such messaging as it's hardly appropriate for us, or any other landlord or electrical, plumbing or other such company who may enter a contaminated property (state or private) to be telling their staff that the new guideline "must be safe".
